

The Department has determined that the Supplemental Remedial Investigation Report is in compliance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E and other applicable requirements. The Department hereby approves the Remedial Investigation Report, effective the date of this letter.

Pursuant to the schedule applicable to the site you shall submit a Revised Remedial Action Workplan and Schedule on December 12, 2007. Please submit the document by that date, or submit a written request for an extension at least 2 weeks prior to the due date. Failure to submit the Revised Remedial Action Workplan and Schedule in accordance with the schedule may result in the initiation of MOA Termination. As a point of clarification, this office has been advised that the wetlands and stream encroachment permits for the project have been denied by the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation. As the current cap design can not be implemented, a revised workplan is required to addressing the existing historic fill.
